

2010 River Gorge Downtown Criterium Rider Instructions

- **Course**

- Familiarize yourself with the course before your race. Course will be open briefly between races.
- There is a course map available on the website. Please be aware that the elevation profile is slightly misleading in that there are no steep elevation gains on the course. We wouldn't do that to you after Saturday. The approach to the finish is a long gradual uphill, but it is not steep by any means.

- **Rider Numbers**

- Numbers should be placed on the back and left-hand side of the jersey. Please do not fold your numbers.
- In addition to bib #'s, you will be issued a mandatory frame number to be placed on your seat post. This helps our crew officiate and score the race, and in the end gives the riders more accurate and timely results.
- Racers that are competing in more than one crit will be issued a separate bib # for each race and must use the correct bib # and frame # for each race.

- **Wheel Pit and Support**

- Wheel pit will be adjacent to the start/finish area. The promoter is not liable for lost or damaged wheels.
- There will be a mechanic tent available near the wheel pit area for minor adjustments and repairs.

- **Junior Rollout**

- All juniors are subject to post-race gear rollout at the finish line, regardless of which race they are competing in. Failure to report to post-race junior rollout can result in relegation.

- **Results**

- Results will be posted adjacent to the start/finish area.
- Please look at your results as soon as they are posted and adhere to the on-site 15 minute protest period.
- Payouts and awards will take place at the start/finish area after the results are finalized.
- Stage and omnium results should be posted throughout the weekend on the TBRA website at www.tbra.org. Notifications of results availability are typically made on TBRA's Twitter account at www.twitter.com/TBRAorg if you want to follow that for the weekend.

- **Payout / Awards**

- Payouts / Medals will be distributed at the finish line area shortly after the protest period is over for each race.
- If you are unable to pick up your awards at the conclusion of the crit, we can mail them to you, but it would be much easier for everyone if you picked them up on site if at all possible.

- **Kiddie Crit**

- The Kiddie Crit is free and available to all children 10 and under.
- Kids and parents will need to register on site and sign a standard USAC release form prior to their race.
